

^{35}Cl NQR, ^1H NMR, and X-Ray Diffraction Studies in a Hydrogen Bonded Complex $\text{Na}_2\text{PtCl}_6 \cdot 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$ *

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The ^{35}Cl NQR frequencies, spin-lattice relaxation time and ^1H NMR relaxation time were measured on crystalline $\text{Na}_2\text{PtCl}_6 \cdot 6\text{H}_2\text{O}$ at 77–350 K. The presence of three nonequivalent chlorine sites found by X-ray diffraction measurement is in agreement with the observed three NQR lines, which have different temperature dependences attributable to differences in the direction of H-bonding with water molecules. The three NQR lines correspond to three kinds of chlorines with different Pt–Cl distances and H-bond directions.
